

[Q&A: COP26 Japan Pavilion / JCM side event on 8<sup>th</sup> November 2021]

Question from an audience

In case renewable power plant project is located in “A” country (JCM partner country) and the electricity generated from the power plant is flown to “B” country (JCM partner country), which means the electricity has been consumed in “B” country, not consumed by the origin power plant, the question is, with this cross border project basis, will JCM Program consider to include this project to be the JCM Model project between Japan and “B” country?

Answer from the organizer of the event

As the JCM Model project is based on the bilateral crediting scheme and targets bilateral projects between Japan and partner country, it is not applicable when the credit allocation is related to 3 or more countries in principle.

However, it depends on the individual project as there are some factors related to the contract details and discussions between partner countries.

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
