[3] 1st issuance of credits from the Joint Crediting Mechanism between Bangladesh and Japan (MOEJ)

On March 28, the Joint Committee of the Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM) between Bangladesh and Japan decided to notify each side of the quantities of credits to be issued for the projects below. This is the first issuance of JCM credits between Bangladesh and Japan, and the projects are supported by the Financing Programme for JCM Model Projects by the Ministry of the Environment, Japan (MOEJ). Based on the contribution to the projects, the Government of Japan (GoJ) will acquire 251 tons of credits.
