[1] MOE Japan Selected 16 Projects for JCM Model Projects of Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM) Financing Support Programme for FY2022 (First Round)

On 1st July, the Ministry of the Environment (MOE), Japan, announced 16 new selected projects for JCM Model Projects of Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM) Financing Support Programme for FY2022 (first round). The number of selected JCM Model Projects has reached 203, and the cumulative reduction of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by FY2030 is expected to be approximately 19 million tons.

MOE Japan has received a variety of JCM Model Projects applications for this first round and selected 16 projects related to energy conservation and renewable energy, such as solar, biomass, and geothermal power generation. MOE Japan will continue to strongly promote the overseas expansion of decarbonizing infrastructure through the JCM, based on the "Plan for Global Warming Countermeasures (Cabinet decision in October 2021)," etc.

The Second Round for the applications for JCM Model Projects selection in FY2022 is open until 29th July.
