
### 2. Background of the Proposed Project



- Uzbekistan's energy supply is <u>highly dependent on</u> <u>fossil fuels</u>. In line with the country's climate change policy, a <u>shift to renewable energy</u> is an important issue for the country.
- 3. Several Uzbek nationals work for HANWA and would like to contribute to solve above issues.



HANWA is aiming to provide stable electricity to hospitals in Uzbekistan utilizing clean energy.







## $\sim$ Clean and Stable Energy Supply to the Hospitals $\sim$




- 1. Replacement from <u>Diesel Generator to Solar Power Generation + Storage Battery</u> as back-up power source in local public hospitals in Uzbekistan which are using grid electric power with unstable supply.
- 2. For heat supply, possibility of conversion from **Coal/Gas Boiler to Biomass Boiler (or Heat pump system)** is considered.
