CLIMATE GOALS OF UKRAINE



NDC: Reduction of total greenhouse gas emissions of Ukraine (including temporarily occupied territories) by 65% by 2030 compared to 1990 emissions

Achieving carbon neutrality of Ukraine's fuel and energy

sector by 2050

Achieving climate neutrality for the country as a whole no later than 2060

Reduce methane emissions by 30% by 2030 from 2020 levels, as per the Global Methane Pledge initiative **Share of renewable energy generation** in total electricity production at 25% in 2030

Eliminate the use of coal in power generation:

for state-owned power plants by 2035, for private power plants - by 2040

Adopted in 2024 by the CMU Order 'On Approval of the National Energy and Climate Plan for the period up to 2030'

EMISSIONS TRADING SYSTEM (ETS)

Draft CMU Order 'On Approval of the Strategy for Implementation of the Emissions Trading System in Ukraine for the Period up to 2033' and its Action Plan - discussion is underway

LONG-TERM LOW-EMISSIONS DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY

LAW OF UKRAINE 'ON THE BASIC PRINCIPLES OF STATE CLIMATE POLICY'

Ministry of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources of Ukraine

PROVIDES FOR

- creation of a climate governance architecture
- EU integration: Implementation of the main provisions of EU Regulation 2021/1119 establishing a framework for achieving climate neutrality and main provisions of EU Regulation 2018/1999 on the governance of the Energy Union and the mitigation of climate change
- setting the principles for the formation of climate policy
- setting a course for achieving climate neutrality
- mandatory consideration of the goals of the state climate policy in local and regional environmental protection programmes
- achieving the goals of the UNFCCC and the Paris Agreement
- establishing fiscal instruments for achieving climate goals
- creation and functioning of market mechanisms and instruments for implementing the state climate policy, including Article 6
- mandatory consideration of the goals of the state climate policy in comprehensive recovery programmes to overcome the consequences of the armed aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine

PROMOTES

- consistent and systematic reduction of greenhouse gas emissions in all sectors of the economy and public policy areas;
- ⊘ increase the absorption of greenhouse gases by sinks;
- ensuring a decent life and sustainable development;
- balance between environmental, economic and social aspects.
