On November 19th, 2015, Ms. Tamayo Marukawa, Minister of the Environment, Japan and H.E. General Surasak Karnjanarat, Minister of Natural Resources and Environment, The Kingdom of Thailand signed the bilateral document of the Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM) in Tokyo. As a result, the JCM will be officially launched in Thailand, becoming the sixteenth country after Mongolia, Bangladesh, Ethiopia, Kenya, Maldives, Viet Nam, Lao PDR, Indonesia, Costa Rica, Palau, Cambodia, Mexico, Saudi Arabia, Chile and Myanmar.
